2. I am already a *Mosaic* subscriber, will I still be able to read *Mosaic*?

Yes. If you are already a *Mosaic* subscriber, you can keep reading *Mosaic*'s Monthly Essays, Observations, and Editors' Picks just like you always have. Simply log in to the new website using your existing *Mosaic* username and password. Your account will transfer over to the new **Tikvah Ideas** website automatically.

3. I am already a MeirSoloveichik.com subscriber, will I still be able to keep accessing Rabbi Soloveichik's podcasts and courses?

Yes. To keep enjoying all of Rabbi Meir Soloveichik's work, simply log in to the new website using your existing Meirsoloveichick.com username and password. Your subscription will transfer over to the new **Tikvah Ideas** website automatically.

4. I was enrolled in a few Tikvah online video courses. Will the new website remember what courses I was taking? Will I still be able to watch them?

Yes. The new **Tikvah Ideas** platform will remember what courses you were enrolled in, and you will continue to have access to them.

5. I have separate accounts for *Mosaic*, *MeirSoloveichik.com*, and some of Tikvah's video courses. Which username and password do I use to log in to Tikvah Ideas?

When you log in to the **Tikvah Ideas** platform for the first time, you can use ANY set of your existing log-in credentials. Whatever username and password you enter **FIRST** will become your log-in credentials for the new website.

6. I used to receive regular newsletters from *Mosaic* and *Meir-Soloveichik.com*. Will I continue to receive those?

Yes. There will be no interruption in *Mosaic's* and *MeirSoloveichik.com's* daily and weekly newsletters.

7. Sometimes, I try to find past articles or videos in previous Tikvah emails. Will those old links still work?

Yes. All old links to previously published Tikvah content will continue to work, and you will be redirected to that content on the new website.

10. How long will my complimentary Society subscription last?

Tikvah Society memberships come up for renewal on an annual basis. Your complimentary **Tikvah Ideas** subscription will last as long as you maintain an active Society membership. If you choose not to renew your annual Society gift, your subscription will lapse 15 months after you first joined the Society.

11. Will past Tikvah event videos be available on the new Tikvah Ideas platform?

Not yet. While most of Tikvah's video productions and courses will be available on the **Tikvah Ideas** website, not every past event video will be immediately available. We are in the process of migrating all that content over, and past event videos will eventually be available through the **Tikvah Ideas** platform as well.

12. Will the new website allow me to share content with people who are not Society members or Tikvah subscribers?

Yes. The **Tikvah Ideas** site easily allows you to gift up to 20 articles/podcasts/videos to anyone you wish.

13. Will the new website remember my progress through different podcasts and courses?
